# **GUIDELINES OF EXAMINATION AND PROMOTION FOR CLASS 5**

(w.e.f. 2023-2024 onwards)

CBSE vide its **Circular No. ACAD-57/2022** dated 20.05.2022 has **restored the Board Exams to the pre-pandemic format, making the Exams ONE phased ONLY**. The Board has, constantly, been initiating further corresponding changes in the Examinations and Assessments Practices also to **align assessment to Competency Based Education (CBE) in line of National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.** 

With restoration of Board Examinations to the pre-pandemic format and also keeping in view the provisions of Right to Education Act, 2009, the DoE-Govt. of NCT of Delhi with the recommendation of SCERT vide its ORDER No. DE.5/212/Exam/16-17/Part-1/717-727 dated 07.10.2022 has introduced New Guidelines for Examination and Promotion for Std. 5 from this Session i.e. 2023-2024 onwards.

# **GUIDELINES OF EXAMINATION**

- Regular Assessment of the students will be done throughout the Academic Session, through Periodic Tests, Mid Term Exam and Annual Exam.
- Each Periodic Test will be of 25 Marks while Mid Term and Annual Exams will be of 50 Marks each.
- Duration of Periodic test will be 01 Hr. whereas the duration for Mid Term and Annual Examinations will be 2 Hrs.
- Syllabus of Class 5 will be separate for both the TERMS. The Question Papers for the Mid Term Examination will be set out of the syllabus of the TERM 1 and ANNUAL EXAMINATION will be held from the Syllabus of the TERM 2 ONLY.
- The Question Papers will be provided in the form of Question Paper Booklets along with space for answering the questions in the booklets itself.

# PASSING CRITERIA FOR CLASS 5

- In order to be declared `PASS' at the end of the session for promotion to the next class, a student must score at least 33% marks in each subject.
- The Promotion to the next higher class is also subject to the condition that a minimum of 25% of marks must be scored in Mid Term Examination plus Annual Examination i.e. 18 marks out of 70 in each subject.

#### **RE-EXAMINATION FOR CLASS 5**

- If a student is unable to appear for Annual Exam, he/she will have to appear for Re-Exam.
- A student who has appeared in the Annual exam is required to appear in Re-Exam in all the failing subjects.
- Re-Exam will be conducted on the same syllabus and pattern as the Annual Exam i.e. 2 Hrs. duration and 50 Marks for Class 5. Weightage of Marks obtained by the student in Re-Examination will be proportionately calculated out of 70 Marks.
- If a student does not secure at least 25% marks in the subject in which he/she has appeared for Re-Exam and a minimum of 33 out of 100 in that subject,

#### OR

- If a student does not appear in Re-Exam, then he/ she will be placed in the category of 'ESSENTIAL REPEAT' (ER) and will be held back in the same class.
- A student of Class 5 who is not eligible for Pass, Promotion and placed in the category of 'Essential Repeat' (ER) will be held back in the same Class during the next session.

# ATTENDANCE CRITERIA FOR CLASS 5

- A student will not be eligible to appear in Annual Exam if he/she doesn't have at least 75% attendance calculated from the beginning of the session/ Date of Admission till the date of Annual Exam.
- Internal Assessment will include 5 Marks for attendance.
