## ACADEMIC ASSESSMENT PLAN

(2022-2023)

CBSE vide its **Circular No. ACAD-57/2022** dated 20.05.2022 declared that the **Board is restoring the Board Exams to the pre-pandemic format, making the Exams ONE phased ONLY**. In continuation to this Circular, the Board is initiating further corresponding changes in the Examinations and Assessments Practices for the year 2022-23 to **align assessment to Competency Based Education (CBE)**. Accordingly, the Board has taken multiple steps towards the implementation of CBE in schools in line of National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.

### STD. IX & X

#### Main Changes:

- **Year End Examination/ Board Examination (Theory) will be ONE phased ONLY.**
- As National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 affirms the need to move from rote to competency Based Learning, **assessment is aligned to Competency Based Education (CBE)**.
- **A greater number of Competency Based Questions** assessing application of concepts in real-life/ unfamiliar situation **will be the part of the question paper.**
- These **Competency Based questions would be minimum 40%**. These can be in the form of MCQs, Case Based Questions, Source Based Integrated Questions or any other type.
- **Objective Type Questions will be 20%.**
- **Remaining 40% will be Short Answer/ Long Answer Questions** as per existing pattern.
- There will be Internal Assessment (IA) of **20% for each of the Five Subjects and for Computer Application – the 6<sup>th</sup> Subject, it will be of 50% weightage**. School is to conduct Periodic Tests to decide the **05% Internal Assessment. Remaining 15% will be taken from Multiple Assessment (5%); portfolio (5%) and Subject Enrichment (5%)**.

**# For Class X, Pre-Mid Term Exam scheduled in 2<sup>nd</sup> Half of December will be assessed as Pre-Board – 1 Examination whereas Pre-Board -2 Examination will be conducted in 2<sup>nd</sup> Half of January.**

**IMPORTANT:**

1. Each of the Three PTs –PT-1, PT-2 & PT-3 is to be converted out of 05. **Average of Best Two PTs is to be calculated. This will be considered as score of Periodic Test (PT) out of 05 for the whole year.**
2. **Multiple Assessments – Average out of 05 (Term – 1 & 2)**
3. **Portfolio – Average out of 05 (Term -1 & 2)**
4. **Subject Enrichment – Average out of 05 (Term – 1 & 2)**
5. **Annual Examination – Out of 80 Marks**

**Students will also be assessed and graded in Co-Scholastic Areas given below:**

1. **Work Education**
2. **Art Education**
3. **Health & Physical Education**

**NOTE:**

- **Students of Class IX have to score 33% Marks separately in Internal Assessment (07 out of 20 marks) and Annual Examination (27 Out of 80 Marks).**
- **There will be no up-scaling of grades in scholastic areas on the basis of co-scholastic grades.**
- **Marks scored by the students of Class X in Pre-Board Examination will be considered for the allocation of Science MED/ Non-MED, Commerce with OR without Mathematics and Humanities with OR without Economics.**

**STD. XI & XII****Main Changes:**

**Year End Examination/ Board Examination (Theory) will be ONE phased ONLY.**

- As National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 affirms the need to move from rote to competency Based Learning, **assessment is aligned to Competency Based Education (CBE).**
- **A greater number of Competency Based Questions** assessing application of concepts in real-life/ unfamiliar situation **will be the part of the question paper.**
- These **Competency Based questions would be minimum 30%.** These can be in the form of MCQs, Case Based Questions, Source Based Integrated Questions or any other type.
- **Objective Type Questions will be 20%.**
- **Remaining 50% will be Short Answer/ Long Answer Questions** (as per existing pattern).
- There will be Internal Assessment (IA)/ **ASL of 20% for English (Core), Hindi (Elective), & Mathematics (To be conducted at School level); Project Work of 20% for History, Political Science, Economics, Business Studies & Accountancy (To be conducted by CBSE deputed External Examiner) AND Practical of 30% for Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Computer Science, Physical Education & Geography (To be conducted by CBSE deputed External).**

**# For Class XII, Pre-Annual Exam scheduled in 2<sup>nd</sup> Half of December will be assessed as Pre-Board – 1 Examination whereas Pre-Board -2 Examination will be conducted in 2<sup>nd</sup> Half of January. IA/ASL/ Project Work/ Practical for Class XII will be scheduled as per the directives and schedule of CBSE.**

**IMPORTANT:**

- The Examination for Class XI would be conducted in Theory as well as in IA/ ASL/ Project Work/ Practical, depending upon the nature of the subject (s) and the marks allotted shall be as prescribed in the curriculum.
- In order to be declared as having passed the Class XI Examinations, a candidate shall obtain 33% marks in all the subjects. The pass marks of each subject of examination shall be 33%. In case of subject involving IA/ ASL/ Project Work/ Practical, a candidate must obtain 33% marks in theory and 33% in IA/ ASL/ Project/ Practical separately in addition to 33% marks in aggregate in order to qualify in that subject.
- A candidate has to appear mandatory in Session Ending/ Annual Examination –Theory and IA/ ASL/ Project/ practical both to be eligible for promotion to class XII.
- The student has to appear in all the examinations to be declared pass/ promoted.
- Compartment Exam will be held by 10<sup>th</sup> April and result will be declared before 15<sup>th</sup> April so that the student attends class XII from 15<sup>th</sup> April onwards.

**Students will also be assessed at School level and graded in Co-Scholastic Areas given below:**

- 1. Work Education**
- 2. General Studies**
- 3. Health & Physical Education**

**Discipline:** The students will also be assessed for the discipline which will be based on the factors like attendance, sincerity, behavior, values, tidiness, respectfulness for rules and regulations, attitude towards society, nation and others. Grading on Discipline will be done term-wise on a 3-point grading scale (**A=Outstanding, B=Very Good and C=Fair**).
