ACADEMIC ASSESSMENT PLAN

(2023-2024)

CBSE vide its Circular No. ACAD-57/2022 dated 20.05.2022 has restored the Board Exams to the prepandemic format, making the Exams ONE phased ONLY. In continuation to this Circular, the Board has initiated corresponding changes in the Examinations and Assessments Practices in the year 2022-23 and is further initiating to align assessment to Competency Based Education (CBE) for the year 2023-2024. Accordingly, the Board has taken multiple steps towards the implementation of CBE in schools in line of National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.

STD. IX - XII

Main Changes:

- Board Exam for STD. X and XII will be ONE Phased ONLY.
- Academic Session for STD. IX and XI has been divided into TWO TERMS –TERM 1 and TERM
 Nomenclature of the Examination of both the terms will be Mid Term Examination to be held in September and Annual Examination in February/ March and Board Exam for STD.
 X and XII.
- The Question Papers for the Mid TERM Examination would be set out of the syllabus of TERM 1 only.
- Whole Syllabus will be covered in Annual examination/ Pre-Board/ Board Examination of STD. IX –
 XII.
- As National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 affirms the need to move from rote to competency Based Learning, assessment is aligned to Competency Based Education (CBE).
- A greater number of Competency Based Questions assessing application of concepts in reallife/ unfamiliar situation will be the part of the question paper.
- These Competency Based questions would be minimum 50% in STD. IX and X whereas this
 would be 40% in STD. XI and XII. These can be in the form of MCQs, Case Based Questions,
 Source Based Integrated Questions or any other type.
- Select Response Type Questions (MCQ) in STD. IX XII would be 20%.
- Remaining 30% in STD. IX and X and 40% in STD. XI and XII will be Short Answer/ Long Answer Questions as per existing pattern.
- For STD. IX and X, there will be Internal Assessment (IA)/ Periodic Assessment of 20% for each of the Five Subjects and for Computer Application the 6th Subject, it will be of 50% weightage. For STD. XI and XII, this would be of 20% in English (Core), Hindi (Elective), Mathematics, History, Political Science, Accountancy and Business Studies whereas for other subjects this would be of 30% weightage.

For Class X, Pre-Annual Exam (PT 3) scheduled in 2nd half of December will be assessed as Pre-Board – 1 Examination whereas Pre-Board -2 Examination will be conducted in 2nd Half of January.

IMPORTANT:

- **1. Periodic Test (PT) -** Using the scores of the Three Periodic Tests (PTs) Annual Average Periodic Test out of 5 Marks will be calculated, which will also be a part of the Internal Assessment/ Periodic Assessment.
- **2. Multiple Assessments –** Average out of 05 (Term 1 & 2)
- **3. Portfolio** Average out of 05 (Term -1 & 2)
- **4. Subject Enrichment** Average out of 05 (Term 1 & 2)
- **5. Mid Term Examination** Will be of 3 hours and with Max. Marks 80. Will be conducted as per CBSE revised curriculum and guidelines.
- **5. Annual Examination** Will be of 3 Hours and with Max. Marks 80. Will be conducted as per CBSE revised curriculum and guidelines.

Students will also be assessed and graded in Co-Scholastic Areas given below:

- 1. Work Education
- 2. Art Education
- 3. Health & Physical Education

NOTE:

- Promotion to the next higher class shall be decided on the basis of the cumulative result of the
 average marks of best two Periodic Test out of three (05 Marks), Multiple Assessment (05 Marks),
 Portfolio (05 Marks), Subject enrichment Activities (05Marks), Mid Term Exam (Weightage will be
 as per DoE guidelines) and Annual Examination (Weightage will be as per DoE guidelines).
- In order to be declared 'Pass' at the end of the session, a student must secure at least 33% marks in each of the Subjects.
- The Promotion is also subject to the condition that a minimum of 25% of marks should be secured in Annual Exam.
- Marks scored by the students of Class X in Pre-Board Examinations will be considered for the allocation of Science MED/ Non-MED, Commerce with OR without Mathematics and Humanities with OR without Economics.

[#] For Class XII, Pre-Annual Exam scheduled in 2nd Half of December will be assessed as Pre-Board – 1 Examination whereas Pre-Board -2 Examination will be conducted in 2nd Half of January. IA/ASL/ Project Work/ Practical for Class XII will be scheduled as per the directives and schedule of CBSE.

IMPORTANT:

- The Examination for Class XI would be conducted in Theory as well as in IA/ ASL/ Project Work/ Practical, depending upon the nature of the subject (s) and the marks allotted shall be as prescribed in the curriculum.
- In order to be declared 'Pass' at the end of the session, a student must secure at least 33% Marks in each of the five main subjects excluding additional subject studied by him/ her during the session subject to the condition that he/ she secures 33% marks separately in theory and in IA/ ASL/ Project/ Practical also.
- The Promotion is also subject to the condition that a minimum of 25% of Marks should be secured in each subject out of five main Subjects in Annual Examination.
- A candidate has to appear mandatory in all the Examination–Theory and IA/ ASL/ Project/ practical both to be eligible for promotion to class XII.
- Compartment Exam will be held by 10th April and result will be declared before 15th April so that the student attends class XII from 15th April onwards.

Students will also be assessed at School level and graded in Co-Scholastic Areas given below:

- 1. Work Education
- 2. General Studies
- 3. Health & Physical Education

Discipline: The students will also be assessed for the discipline which will be based on the factors like attendance, sincerity, behavior, values, tidiness, respectfulness for rules and regulations, attitude towards society, nation and others. Grading on Discipline will be done term-wise on a 3-point grading scale (**A=Outstanding**, **B=Very Good and C=Fair**).
