## ACADEMIC ASSESSMENT PLAN FOR STD. VI - VIII

(2023-2024)

CBSE vide its **Circular No. ACAD-57/2022** dated 20.05.2022 has **restored the Board Exams to the pre-pandemic format, making the Exams ONE phased ONLY**. The Board has, constantly, been initiating further corresponding changes in the Examinations and Assessments Practices also to **align assessment to Competency Based Education (CBE) in line of National Education Policy (NEP) 2020**.

**With restoration of Board Examinations to the pre-pandemic format and also keeping in view the provisions of Right to Education Act, 2009, the DoE-Govt. of NCT of Delhi with the recommendation of SCERT vide its ORDER No. DE.5/212/Exam/16-17/Part-1/717-727 dated 07.10.2022 has restructured the Assessment and Promotion Plan for STD. VI – VIII w.e.f. Academic Session 2023-2024. The scheme for STD. VI - VIII is designed on TERM ASSESSMENT and the coverage of the whole syllabus, covered in TERM 1 and TERM 2 in Annual Examination has also been implemented.** This would prepare the students to cover the whole syllabus of the academic year and face the challenge of class X Board Examination, and would thus, ensure the 'Quality of Education'.

### Main Changes:

- Syllabus of STD. VI – VIII will be separate for both the TERMS. The **Question Papers for the Mid Term Examination will be set out of the Syllabus of the TERM – 1**.
- **The Question Papers for the Annual Examinations in VI – VIII will be set out of the whole syllabus, covered in TERM 1 and TERM 2.**
- Assessment of STD. VI and VII will be done on the same examination pattern as of STD. VIII.
- In order to be declared 'PASS' (Applicable for STD. VIII) at the end of the session for promotion to the next higher class, a **student must secure at least 33% marks in each subject studied by him/ her during the session. The promotion to the next higher class is also subject to the condition that a minimum of 25% of marks must be scored in Annual Examination.**
- Regular Assessment of a student of STD. VI – VIII will be done regularly throughout the academic session as per the weightage of marks given in the table.

### **IMPORTANT:**

- Each of the Two PTs – scheduled in July and November 2023 will be of 75 Minutes duration whereas the Mid Term and Annual Examinations will be of 2.5 Hours duration. The pattern of Periodic Tests will be same as Mid Term and Annual Examinations.
- For the Assessments at S. No. 1 – 6 in both the TERMS – TERM 1 AND TERM 2, the Average Score out of 05 will be recorded in the Annual Progress Report of the Child.
